

Role of Parent/Family Chaperone On Field Trips

We welcome parents and family members to accompany us on trips away from the center. However, as a chaperone we do ask that you abide by the policies that have been set. Please read, sign, and return this form to the center prior to the field trip date.

- Parents/Family members are not responsible for supervising any groups, large or small, of children while on a field trip. Supervision of the children is the responsibility of the teachers and staff.
- Parents/Family members are not allowed to be alone with any child/children other than their own. If taking their own child/children away from the group (to the restroom, leaving the site, etc.), a teacher or staff member must be notified so it can be properly documented.
- Parents/Family members are not allowed to discipline other children, and are encouraged to use only positive guidance and redirection with their own child/children. It is the responsibility of the teachers and staff to manage any behavior issues that arise with the children.
- Parents/Family members are expected to model appropriate behaviors for the children, and abide by the guidelines set by the teachers/staff and the site being visited.
